

## **Language and psycho-physiology in the philosophy of Nietzsche**

### **Abstract:**

This paper aims to present some general relations between philosophy and language in the work of Friedrich Nietzsche and, in particular, the demolition process undertaken by the philosopher about the metaphysical principles from which the Western discourse would have been structured. Conceiving of language as a mere offshoot of will to power, the philosopher ends up moving it from metaphysics immanence assessed by tradition, evaluating it under a psycho-physiological perspective. In other words, for Nietzsche, language leaves metaphysical ontology to be understood as just one of the events of the organic world: logical fictions useful to life.
