

The question of academic freedom in Schleiermacher and Nietzsche

Abstract:

The article deals firstly with some fundamental principles of the modern university, having Friedrich Schleiermacher as reference, in order to make understandable, within which theoretical context was conceived the idea of "academic freedom" and – linked to it – of "student freedom". In this manner can become clearer the criticism made by Nietzsche to the "Higher Education Institutions" decades later, before a format of University that did not correspond to the noble goals of the time of its foundation.
